MEDICATION POLICY

If your Junior Zoo Crew member has medication that must be given during the program day, all medicine must be in its original prescription container with the dosage, your child's name, and the prescribing physician's name clearly marked on the container.

FEVER POLICY

If a Junior Zoo Crew member gets sick during the program, they will be sent home and not allowed back into the zoo for the remainder of the day. Junior Zoo Crew members who are sick prior to coming to their scheduled program day, are not allowed to attend until they have been fever-free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medication. The program day will not be prorated or refunded for the missed program day. This is for the safety of others on program, zoo staff, as well as the animals within the zoo.

FOOD AND ALLERGY POLICY

We will occasionally provide frozen ice pops on these hot summer days in Texas (if you have any objections to this, please notify Worldwide Wildlife Staff). Otherwise, we do not provide any food for the Junior Zoo Crew. Please have your Junior Zoo Crew member bring a sack lunch and snacks for their scheduled program days.
